### CHOIR MASTER

Either of the following works may be substituted for Copland's "At the River":

David Hurd: "Love Bade Me Welcome" (Selah 418-610).

Rosephanye Powell: "The Word Was God" (Gentry Publications JG2323).

### ASSOCIATESHIP

The following work may be substituted for any piece in List C:

Fanny Mendelssohn Hensel: Prelude in F for organ (Harbach Music H304 [formerly Vivace Press]; [bharbach@umsl.edu](mailto:bharbach@umsl.edu); [BarbaraHarbach.com](http://BarbaraHarbach.com))

One of the following works may be substituted for any work in List D:

Adolphus Hailstork: Prelude in trio style on "We Shall Overcome" from his *Four Spirituals* (MorningStar Music MN10-896).

Libby Larsen: Prelude on "Veni creator spiritus" (Edition Peters 9780193864603).

Alberto Ginastera: Fugue on BACH, from *Toccata, Villancico y Fuga*, Op. 18 (Boosey & Hawkes BHI 400122).

### FELLOWSHIP

Either of the following may be substituted for an item in List C; please note that *either* of these will qualify as a slow movement and that only one such movement can be played as part of the repertoire section of the examination:

- \* Jeanne Demessieux: Consolateur, from *Sept Méditations sur le Saint-Esprit*, Op. 6 (Durand DF 01331200).
- \* Undine Smith Moore: Variations on "Nettleton" (available in *African-American Organ Music Anthology*, vol. 2, MorningStar Music MN10-546).

Either of the following may be substituted for an item in List D; these do *not* qualify as slow movements:

Margaret Sandresky: Toccata: "Veni creator spiritus" (available in *Margaret Vardell Sandresky Organ Music*, vol. I [ed. Virginia L. Haisten], Wayne Leupold WL600031).
